Ro 15:5 May the God who gives endurance and encouragement **give you a spirit of unity among yourselves as you follow Christ Jesus**, Ro 15:6 so that with one heart and mouth you may glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. Ro 15:7 Accept one another, then, just as Christ accepted you, in order to bring praise to God.

Eph 4:1 As a prisoner for the Lord, then, I urge you to <u>live a life worthy of the calling you have received.</u>

4:2 Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, bearing with one another in love. Eph 4:3 <u>Make every</u>

effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace. Eph 4:4 There is one body and one

Spirit—just as you were called to one hope when you were called Eph 4:5 one Lord, one faith, one baptism;

Eph 4:6 one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all.

Ps 133:1 How good and pleasant it is when brothers live together in unity!

^{1Co} ^{1:10} I appeal to you, brothers, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that all of you <u>agree with one</u> <u>another so that there may be no divisions among you</u> and that you may be <u>perfectly united in mind and thought</u>.

Phil 2:1 If you have any encouragement from being united with Christ, if any comfort from his love, if any fellowship with the Spirit, if any tenderness and compassion, Phil 2:2 then make my joy complete by being like-minded, having the same love, being one in spirit and purpose.

^{2Ch} ^{30:12} Also in Judah the <u>hand of God was on the people to give them unity of mind</u> to carry out what the king and his officials had ordered, following the word of the LORD.

Jn 17:11 I will remain in the world no longer, but they are still in the world, and I am coming to you. Holy Father, protect them by the power of your name the name you gave me so that they may be one as we are one.

^{Col 3:12} Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience. ^{Col 3:13} Bear with each other and forgive whatever grievances you may have against one another. Forgive as the Lord forgave you. ^{Col 3:14} And over all these virtues <u>put on love</u>, <u>which binds them all together in perfect unity</u>. ^{Col 3:15} Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, since <u>as members of one body</u> you were called to peace. And be thankful.

^{Col 2:2} My purpose is that they may be encouraged in heart and <u>united in love</u>, so that they may have the full riches of complete understanding, in order that they may know the mystery of God, namely, Christ, ^{Col 2:3} in whom are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge. ^{Col 2:4} I tell you this <u>so that no one may deceive you by fine-sounding arguments</u>.



Eph 4:11 It was he who gave some to be apostles, some to be prophets, some to be evangelists, and some to be pastors and teachers, Eph 4:12 to prepare God's people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up Eph 4:13 until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God and become mature, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ.
